





# **EXPECTED OUTPUTS**

- The training of at least 400 local community members in alternative livelihoods and skills;
- The participation of at least 400 local community members in activities aimed at increasing awareness and changing behavior with regard to social/gender and health issues;
- The training of at least 400 local community members in gender issues; and
- 5) Pilot gender-responsive transportation initiatives in eight communities in the Southern Highlands and Enga provinces
